1. The Bible was the verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit and penned by Spirit-filled men. It is the inerrant and authoritative Word of God (2 Tim. 3:15-17, 2 Peter 1:19-21).
2. The triune God-head is composed of three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each of them execute distinct but harmonious offices (Deut. 6:4, Mt. 3:6-17, Mt. 28:19, 2 Cor. 13:14. 1 John 5:7).
 - a. The Father, who is Spirit, infinite, eternal and unchangeable in all His attributes (Ex. 34:6, John 4:24).
 - b. The Son, Jesus Christ: His Deity, the virgin birth, sinless life, atoning death, bodily resurrection, personal exaltation at God's right hand and his return (Is. 7:14, Mt. 1:20-23, John 4:24, Acts 1:11, 1 Cor. 15:3-4, 2 Cor. 5:21).
 - c. The Holy Spirit, who is a divine person, equal with the Father and the Son and is of the same nature (John 15:26, John 14:16-17, Mt. 28:19).
3. Satan is a created being and a fallen angel (Is. 14:12-17, Ez. 28:12-19). He has a distinct personality (Job 1:7, Job 2:6, Rev. 20:2), is the unholy god of this age (2Cor. 4:4, John 12:31), and the author of all sin and spiritual darkness (Mt. 4:1-3).
4. Man was created by God without sin (Gen. 1:26-27). However, Man sinned and became a fallen creature (Gen. 3:1-7). Consequently, he is completely deprived and in need of a Savior (Rom. 5:12, Gal. 3:22).
5. Salvation is by grace through faith in the shed blood of the substitutionary death of Jesus Christ, our Savior (Titus 3:4-7, Eph. 2:8-9, Rom. 5:8).
6. There is eternal blessedness for the saved and everlasting punishment for the lost (John 3:16, Eph. 2:8-9).
7. When Christ returns there will be a judgement for His redeemed people. They will give an account for what they have done on earth whether good or bad (1 Cor. 3:10-15, Rom. 14:12, 2 Cor. 5:10).
8. The universal Church is composed of all true followers of Jesus Christ. It is referred to as the Body of Christ and is exhorted to work together with one, unified purpose -- furthering the work of God (1 Cor. 10:32, 1 Cor. 12:13, Eph. 1:22-23, Eph. 5:30-32, Col. 1:18-24).
